History of

Institution

The Educational Society named Vidyapati Sansthan was founded by Shri Baldev Raj Kamrah and Late Smt. Satya Kamrah, the Gandhians who are long committed to excellence in education. The Kamrah couple were brought up and trained as social workers in Gandhi Gram University. It is there that they imbibed true Gandhian ideals. Incidentally their training was sponsored by Gandhi Smarak Nidhi, New Delhi. Later Gandhi Smarak Nidhi entrusted to them the GRAM EKAI programme in village Hastal of Najafgarh Block in Delhi. Staying in the village itself both Shri and Smt. Kamrah dedicated themselves wholeheartedly to the programme. They undertook the sanitation work, observed a strict routine of "PRABHAT PHERIES", cleaning of streets followed by Gandhi Ji's prayer. Shri Kamrah himself is an alumnus of PILANI Educational Institute where he was a student from 1948 to 1952. Inspired by Pilani's educational ambience, he dreamt of establishing educational centers in Delhi and the NCR. His Mission was to create these institutions as sources of inspiration in the form of value based educational centers to meet the contemporary needs. He always had the Vision of bringing change in the society through value based education without which, in his words 'India cannot regain its status of "Mother of Love" and "Princess of Peace" among the family of Nations in the world'. Both husband & wife were intensely loved by late Padma Bhusan Jainendra Kumar Ji- the Gandhian literator, Late Padma Vibhushan Km. Nirmla Deshpande, Shri C.A. Menon and Late Sh. C.K. Nair who remained fully associated with Kamrahs till they breathed their last. Today, the Society has well established KIIT Group of Colleges of professional education founded by him, In addition, today there are a number of schools under the KIIT banner imparting quality education to the masses both in Delhi and Gurugram (Haryana). KIIT College of Education functions under the aegis of Vidyapati Sansthan, a registered education society. This progressive and philanthropic organization was founded by Shri B.R. Kamrah and Late Smt. Satya Kamrah way back in 1969 to exemplify the brightest virtues of holistic education. <p>Significant Achievements, if any</p>	<p>School Enterprise Challenge-2015 Under our skill development initiative in teacher education we have come up with a new business idea this year (2015 – 16). It includes among other things designing, preparing and selling along with marketing handicrafts items. We have given a name to our business i.e. 'CREATIVE ARTS'. B.Ed and M.Ed Students of the College participated in School Enterprise Challenge 2015 Competition with great enthusiasm and in big number. The School Enterprise Challenge (SEC) is a Student–led, business start-up competition for schools round the world. As a culmination of the first phase of School Enterprise Challenge an International Conference on “21st Century Skills: Creating a Generation of Entrepreneurs” (19th November – 21st November 2015) was organized in KIIT Campus. 200 delegates from 25 countries and 5 continents comprising of educators, development practitioners, academics, business people, international institutions, and donors participated in the conference. A market place was a special part of the conference. In this delegates were offered a “Market Stall” each to present their work, and sell their products. Our SEC team participated in the Market Place along with other countries. They exhibited various products for sale such as jute bags, handicraft items, Decorated earthen pots, decorated diyas, jewellery items, Mehandi stall, file folders and Paintings, etc. Sale of our products in just 2 hours was 34,440 Indian Rupees. KIIT College of Education, Gurugram, India received award for highest sale.</p> <p>Online Open Group CTET &amp; HTET Preparation( A New Initiative) College faculty member Ms. Kanchan Khatreja has taken the initiative to offer free online preparation opportunity to the students for Teacher Eligibility Test. We have launched a group namely HTET &amp; CTET PREPARATION GROUP for the aspirants. It is an open group anybody can join us by sending a request. We have so far enrolled 220 members. Everyday 10 questions are uploaded for the practice and after 24 hours correct answers are also updated for the student’s knowledge. Feedback is also provided. Creation of a Research Section in the Library A special research section has been created in the college library. The library has been enriched by collecting theses/dissertations from different universities, learning materials developed by IGNOU, MPBOU, NIOS, and NUEPA, Literature from CBT, NCERT and digital collections.
