- Abstract (not more than 300 words) and Keywords (not more than 5 words)
- Introduction/ Background/ Objective
- Review of Related Literature
- Methodology, Findings, Analysis & Discussion
- Conclusion and Recommendations
- References- APA Style is required.
- Tables, figures, etc. In their appropriate location in the paper (if applicable)
- Margins: 1 inch or 2.5 cm. Font (12): Times New Roman (English), Krutidev 011 (Hindi)
- Spacing: 1.5 between lines and 2 between paragraphs
