

GENERAL RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

- 1. A bonafide student of the College of Education (B.El.Ed., D.Ed., B.Ed. & M.Ed.) can participate in the competitions.
- 2. A student cannot participate in more than one event.
- 3. A code will be allotted to each participant college and participants need to mention their respective college code on the prepared & recorded items.
- 4. Recorded videos are required to be uploaded in a single folder created in google drive with college code (to be given by the host college) by the participant college and the link should be shared through mail at kced@kiitworld.in
- 5. The video file must be in .mp4 format. Videos that are not in this file format will be disqualified.
- 6. The college may send two entries to each event.
- 7. The team may disqualify for exceeding time or deviating from the theme.
- 8. E- Certificates for the First, Second, and Third positions will be given to the winners.
- 9. The decision of the judges will be final.
- 10. Results will be announced in Valedictory Programme on 05th May 2023.



COMPETITION GUIDELINES

Poster Making

THEMES:

- *E-WASTE MANAGEMENT
- *GOING PAPER LESS
- 3 R'S- REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE
- 1. Each participant can submit only one poster on any one of the themes.
- 2. The poster must be made on A3 size sheet with margin drawn with black pen/marker.
- 3. Acceptable tools for drawing/painting include pencil, crayon, watercolour, oil paint, etc.
- 4. Photographs, wires, other 3D objects, and printouts are not acceptable. The figures appear on the poster should be ORIGINAL and handmade.
- 5. File Size: Maximum file size should be 4 Megabytes (4MB).
- 6. File Format: Save your file as PDF/JPEG format and the file name must be participant name along with college code.
- 7. Any participant found violating rules and regulations will be disqualified from the competition.
- 8. No poster should include any image or name of government officials or popular personalities.
- 9. Posters with spelling errors will automatically be eliminated.
- 10. The participant must upload three photos showing him/her during the art making process: one at the start, one in the middle and one at the end and will send on the provided E-Mail ID. A 30-45 second video should also be sent on mail showing the participant while making the art. Please keep in mind that the artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the above photos and videos.
- 11. Any late submission will not be accepted.

- 1. Each participant can submit only one artwork.
- 2. The Doodle must be made on A3 size sheet.
- 3. Acceptable tools for drawing/painting include pencil, black pens and Markers.
- 4. Photographs, wires, other 3D objects, printouts are not acceptable.
- 5. File name must be participant name with college code for easy and quick upload.
- 6. Any participant found violating rules and regulation will be disqualified from the competition.
- 7. Doodles with spelling errors will automatically be eliminated.
- 8. The participant must upload three photos showing him/her during the art making process: one at the start, one in the middle and one at the end and will send on the provided E-Mail ID. A 30-45 second video should also be sent on the mail showing the participant while making the art. Please keep in mind that the artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the above photos and videos.
- 9. Any late submission will not be accepted.

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- 1. Participants will show their creativity and talk about it in a two minute video.
- 2. Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.
- 3. Other than waste material, glue/fevicol, pins, colours, lace, scissors, thread etc. can be used to enhance and give finishing to Art work.
- 4. The item would be rejected if not found to be a waste product or second hand item.
- 5. No ready or semi-finished model or matter would be accepted from participant in competition.
- 6. The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding.

<u>Judgement Criterion</u>: Creativity, Utilization of Resources, Artistic Composition & Design, Eco-Friendly Rating, Utility of the Product and Overall Presentation.





- 1. General rules of participation must be followed.
- 2. A college may send one entry in Any Two of the following pedagogy su combinations.
 - (a) Languages- Pedagogy of English, Hindi, and Sanskrit.
 - (b) Mathematics & Sciences- Pedagogy of Mathematics, Computer Science, Biological Science, Physical Sciences, and Home Science.
 - (c) Social Sciences- Pedagogy of Social Studies, History, Geography, Political Science, Economics & Commerce.
- 3. Participants will prepare a lesson plan related to the theme or of their own choice.
- 4. A 6 to 10 minute video, clearly depicting the participant delivering the lesson, must be submitted along with the lesson plan at the given email ID before the last date of submission.
- 5. If the video exceeded 10 minutes, only the first ten (10) minutes of the video will be judged.
- 6. Specific teaching aid(s)- digital / non-digital, to be used by the participant should be self-made.
- 7. Participant may present their lesson in Hindi or English medium, except language group.
- 8. The covering page of the lesson plan and/ or presentation must clearly specify the participant's details like college code, pedagogy subject, & any other relevant information he/ she wish to share.

<u>Judgement Criterion</u>: Content knowledge, Communication skills, Chalk board work, / Use of specific teaching aids (including ICT tools) & Overall presentation
